

**\*Genesis 1:1 (EHV)** In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.

**Genesis 8:21 (EHV)** ...the thoughts he forms in his heart are evil from his youth.

**Genesis 32:10 (EHV)** <sup>10</sup> I am not worthy of even a bit of all the mercy and all the faithfulness that you have shown to your servant.

**Genesis 39:9 (EHV)** How then could I do such a great evil and sin against God?"

**Exodus 20:11 (EHV)** For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and everything that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day.

**Deuteronomy 33:27 (EHV)** <sup>27</sup> The everlasting God is a dwelling place, and his eternal arms are under you.

**Job 19:25 (EHV)** <sup>25</sup>As for me, I know that my Redeemer lives, and that at the end of time he will stand over the dust.

**Job 19:26 (EHV)** <sup>26</sup>Then, even after my skin has been destroyed, nevertheless, in my own flesh I will see God.

**Job 19:27 (EHV)** <sup>27</sup>I myself will see him. My own eyes will see him, and not as a stranger. My emotions are in turmoil within me.

**Psalms 14:1 (EHV)** The fool says in his heart, "There is no God."

**Psalms 23:6 (EHV)** Surely goodness and mercy will pursue me all the days of my life, and I will live in the house of the LORD forever.

**Psalms 24:1 (EHV)** <sup>1</sup>The earth is the LORD's and everything that fills it, the world and all who live in it,

**Psalm 31:15 (EHV)** My times are in your hand.

**Psalm 32:5 (EHV)** <sup>5</sup>I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover up my guilt. I said, “I will confess my rebellion to the LORD,” and you forgave the guilt of my sin.

**Psalm 37:5 (EHV)** <sup>5</sup>Commit your way to the LORD. Trust in him, and he will act.

**\*Psalm 50:15 (EHV)** <sup>15</sup>Call on me in the day of distress. I will deliver you, and you will honor me.

**Psalm 51:9 (EHV)** <sup>9</sup>Hide your face from my sins. Erase all my guilty deeds.

**Psalm 51:10 (EHV)** <sup>10</sup>Create in me a pure heart, O God. Renew an unwavering spirit within me.

**Psalm 56:11 (EHV)** <sup>11</sup>In God I trust. I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?

**Psalm 91:11 (EHV)** <sup>11</sup>Because he will give a command to his angels concerning you, to guard you in all your ways.

**Psalm 100:2 (EHV)** <sup>2</sup>Serve the LORD with gladness. Come before him with joyful songs.

**Psalm 103:1 (EHV)** <sup>1</sup>Bless<sup>a</sup> the LORD, O my soul. All that is within me, bless his holy name.

(<sup>a</sup>1 God blesses us by giving us gifts. We bless God by praising him.)

**Psalm 103:2 (EHV)** <sup>2</sup>Bless the LORD, O my soul. And do not forget all his benefits—

**\*Psalm 118:1 (EHV)** <sup>1</sup>Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his mercy endures forever.

**Psalm 119:47 (EHV)** <sup>47</sup>For I delight in your commandments, which I love.

**\*Psalm 119:105 (EHV)** <sup>105</sup>Your words are a lamp for my feet and a light for my path.

**Psalm 122:1 (EHV)** <sup>1</sup>I rejoiced with those who said to me, “Let us go to the house of the LORD.”

**\*Psalm 124:8 (EHV)** <sup>8</sup>Our help is in the name of the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.

**\*Psalm 139:14 (EHV)** <sup>14</sup>I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Your works are wonderful, and my soul knows that very well.

**Psalm 145:13 (EHV)** The LORD is faithful to all his words and merciful toward all he has made.

**Psalm 145:15 (EHV)** <sup>15</sup>The eyes of all look eagerly to you, and you give them their food at the proper time.

**Psalm 145:16 (EHV)** <sup>16</sup>He opens his hand, and he satisfies the desire of every living thing.

**Psalm 146:2 (EHV)** <sup>2</sup>I will praise the LORD as long as I live. I will make music to my God as long as I exist.

**\*Proverbs 3:5 (EHV)** <sup>5</sup>Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding.

**Proverbs 13:24 (EHV)** <sup>24</sup>A person who withholds his rod hates his son, but one who loves him administers discipline promptly.

**Proverbs 22:6 (EHV)** <sup>6</sup>Dedicate<sup>b</sup> a child to the way he should go, and even when he becomes old, he will not turn away from it.

(<sup>b</sup>6 Or *consecrate*. The Hebrew word used here is not one of the usual words for teaching or training, but is the same word used for dedicating a temple. It adds the connotation of entrusting the child to the LORD as Hannah did.)

**\*Isaiah 41:10 (EHV)** <sup>10</sup>Do not fear, for I am with you. Do not be overwhelmed,<sup>c</sup> for I am your God.

(<sup>c</sup>10 Or *dismayed*)

**Isaiah 43:1 (EHV)** Do not be afraid, because I have redeemed you. I have called you by name. You are mine.

**\*Isaiah 43:11 (EHV)** <sup>11</sup>I, yes I, am the LORD, and apart from me there is no savior.

**Isaiah 53:6 (EHV)** <sup>6</sup>We all have gone astray like sheep. Each of us has turned to his own way, but the LORD has charged all our guilt to him.

**Isaiah 59:2 (EHV)** <sup>2</sup>No, it is your guilt that has separated you from your God.

**Isaiah 64:6 (EHV)** <sup>6</sup>All of us have become like something unclean, and all our righteous acts are like a filthy cloth.

**Jeremiah 29:11 (EHV)** <sup>11</sup>For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans to give you peace, not disaster, plans to give you hope and a future.

**Ezekiel 18:4 (EHV)** The soul who sins is the one who will die.

**Matthew 1:21 (EHV)** <sup>21</sup> She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.

**\*Matthew 4:10 (EHV)** Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.

**\*Matthew 6:33 (EHV)** <sup>33</sup> But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

**\*Matthew 7:7 (EHV)** “Keep asking, and it will be given to you. Keep seeking, and you will find. Keep knocking, and it will be opened for you.

**Matthew 10:28 (EHV)** <sup>28</sup> Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, fear the one who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

**\*Matthew 11:28 (EHV)** <sup>28</sup> “Come to me all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

**\*Matthew 18:20 (EHV)** <sup>20</sup> In fact where two or three have gathered together in my name, there I am among them.”

**\*Matthew 22:37 (EHV)** Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.

**\*Matthew 22:39 (EHV)** Love your neighbor as yourself.

**\*Matthew 26:41 (EHV)** <sup>41</sup> Watch and pray, so that you do not enter into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.”

**\*Matthew 28:19 (EHV)** <sup>19</sup> Therefore go and gather disciples from all nations by baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

**\*Matthew 28:20 (EHV)** <sup>20</sup> and by teaching them to keep all the instructions I have given you. And surely I am with you always until the end of the age.”

**Mark 9:24 (EHV)** “I do believe. Help me with my unbelief!”

**\*Mark 10:45 (EHV)** <sup>45</sup> For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

**\*Mark 16:15 (EHV)** Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

**\*Mark 16:16 (EHV)** <sup>16</sup> Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

**Luke 1:37 (EHV)** For nothing will be impossible for God.

**Luke 2:6–7 (EHV)** <sup>6</sup> And so it was that while they were there, the time came for her to give birth. <sup>7</sup> And she gave birth to her firstborn son, wrapped him in swaddling cloths, and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

**Luke 2:10 (EHV)** <sup>10</sup> But the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid. For behold, I bring you good news of great joy, which will be for all people:

**Luke 2:11 (EHV)** Today in the town of David, a Savior was born for you. He is Christ the Lord.

**\*Luke 11:28 (EHV)** “Even more blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it.”

**\*Luke 18:13 (EHV)** God, be merciful to me, a sinner!

**\*John 1:29 (EHV)** Look! The Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

**\*John 3:16 (EHV)** <sup>16</sup> “For God so loved the world that he gave his only-begotten Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

**John 5:23 (EHV)** <sup>23</sup> so that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent him.

**John 5:39 (EHV)** <sup>39</sup> You search the Scriptures because you think you have eternal life in them. They testify about me!

**John 6:68 (EHV)** <sup>68</sup> Simon Peter answered him, “Lord, to whom will we go? You have the words of eternal life.

**John 8:31 (EHV)** <sup>31</sup> So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, “If you remain in my word, you are really my disciples.

**\*John 8:47 (EHV)** <sup>47</sup> Whoever belongs to God listens to what God says. The reason you do not listen is that you do not belong to God.”

**John 10:35 (EHV)** The Scripture cannot be broken,

**\*John 11:25–26 (EHV)** <sup>25</sup> Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me will live, even if he dies. <sup>26</sup> And whoever lives and believes in me will never perish. Do you believe this?”

**\*John 14:19 (EHV)** Because I live, you also will live.

**Acts 4:12 (EHV)** <sup>12</sup> “There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people by which we must be saved.”

**Acts 4:20 (EHV)** <sup>20</sup> For we cannot stop speaking about what we have seen and heard.”

**\*Acts 5:29 (EHV)** We must obey God rather than men.

**Acts 16:31 (EHV)** “Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, you and your household.”

**Romans 1:16 (EHV)** <sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes...

**Romans 3:20 (EHV)** ...Through the law we become aware of sin.

**\*Romans 3:23–24 (EHV)** All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God <sup>24</sup> and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

**\*Romans 6:23 (EHV)** <sup>23</sup> For the wages of sin is death, but the undeserved gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**Romans 8:1 (EHV)** There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

**\*Romans 8:28 (EHV)** <sup>28</sup> We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God, for those who are called according to his purpose...

**\*Romans 10:17 (EHV)** <sup>17</sup> So then, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message comes through the word of Christ.

**Romans 13:10 (EHV)** ...love is the fulfillment of the law.

**\*1 Corinthians 10:31 (EHV)** <sup>31</sup> So whether you eat or drink, or do anything else, do everything to the glory of God.

**1 Corinthians 12:3 (EHV)** <sup>3</sup> Therefore I am informing you that no one speaking by God’s Spirit says, “A curse be upon Jesus,” and no one can say, “Jesus is Lord,” except by the Holy Spirit.

**2 Corinthians 5:15 (EHV)** <sup>15</sup> And he died for all, so that those who live would no longer live for themselves but for him, who died in their place and was raised again.

**2 Corinthians 8:9 (EHV)** <sup>9</sup> For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that although he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that through his poverty you might become rich.

**2 Corinthians 9:7 (EHV)** <sup>7</sup> Each one should give as he has determined in his heart, not reluctantly or under pressure, for God loves a cheerful giver.

**Galatians 3:26 (EHV)** <sup>26</sup> In fact, you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

**Galatians 3:27 (EHV)** <sup>27</sup> Indeed, as many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

**\*Galatians 4:4–5 (EHV)** <sup>4</sup> But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son to be born of a woman, so that he would be born under the law, <sup>5</sup> in order to redeem those under the law, so that we would be adopted as sons.

**\*Galatians 5:13 (EHV)** ... Serve one another through love.

**Galatians 6:10 (EHV)** <sup>10</sup> So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who belong to the household of faith.

**Ephesians 1:7 (EHV)** <sup>7</sup> In him we also have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in keeping with the riches of his grace,

**\*Ephesians 2:8–9 (EHV)** <sup>8</sup> Indeed, it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— <sup>9</sup> not by works, so that no one can boast.

**Ephesians 3:20 (EHV)** <sup>20</sup> Now to him, who is able, according to the power that is at work within us, to do infinitely more than we can ask or imagine,

**Ephesians 4:18 (EHV)** <sup>18</sup> They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, due to the hardness of their hearts.

**\*Ephesians 4:32 (EHV)** Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one other, just as God in Christ has forgiven us.

**\*Ephesians 6:1 (EHV)** <sup>1</sup> Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

**Philippians 2:8 (EHV)** <sup>8</sup> he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death—even death on a cross.

**Colossians 2:9 (EHV)** <sup>9</sup> For all the fullness of God’s being dwells bodily in Christ.

**Colossians 3:20 (EHV)** Children, obey your parents in everything, for this is pleasing in the Lord.

**1 Timothy 1:15 (EHV)** “Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners,” of whom I am the worst.

**\*1 Timothy 2:3–4 (EHV)** God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

**1 Timothy 6:7 (EHV)** <sup>7</sup> For we brought nothing into the world, and we certainly cannot take anything out.

**1 Timothy 6:10 (EHV)** <sup>10</sup> For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evils...

**2 Timothy 2:19 (EHV)** <sup>19</sup> ...“The Lord knows those who are his,”...

**\*2 Timothy 3:15 (EHV)** <sup>15</sup> and that from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

**\*2 Timothy 3:16 (EHV)** <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is God breathed and is useful for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, and for training in righteousness,

**Hebrews 11:1 (EHV)** <sup>1</sup> Faith is being sure about what we hope for, being convinced about things we do not see.

**Hebrews 13:5 (EHV)** <sup>5</sup> Keep your life free from the love of money, and be content with what you have. For God has said: I will never leave you, and I will never forsake you.

**James 1:17 (EHV)** <sup>17</sup> Every good act of giving and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the lights.

**James 1:22 (EHV)** <sup>22</sup> Be people who do what the word says, not people who only hear it. Such people are deceiving themselves.

**1 Peter 3:15 (EHV)** <sup>15</sup> But regard the Lord, the Christ, as holy in your hearts. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give a reason for the hope that is in you.

**\*1 Peter 5:7 (EHV)** Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you.

**\*1 Peter 5:8 (EHV)** <sup>8</sup> Have sound judgment. Be alert. Your adversary, the Devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.

**\*1 John 1:7 (EHV)** The blood of Jesus Christ, his Son, cleanses us from all sin.

**1 John 1:9 (EHV)** <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**1 John 2:1 (EHV)** <sup>1</sup> My children, I write these things to you so that you will not sin. If anyone does sin, we have an Advocate before the Father: Jesus Christ, the Righteous One.

**1 John 2:2 (EHV)** <sup>2</sup> He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the whole world.

**1 John 3:15 (EHV)** <sup>15</sup> Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life remaining in him.

**1 John 4:8 (EHV)** <sup>8</sup> The one who does not love has not known God, because God is love.

**1 John 4:10 (EHV)** <sup>10</sup> This is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins.

**\*1 John 4:19 (EHV)** <sup>19</sup> We love because he first loved us.

**1 John 5:3 (EHV)** <sup>3</sup> In fact, this is love for God: that we keep his commands. And his commands are not burdensome,

**\*Revelation 2:10 (EHV)** Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

**Revelation 7:17 (EHV)** And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.

## The Ten Commandments

### THE FIRST COMMANDMENT

You shall have no other gods.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.

### THE SECOND COMMANDMENT

You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we do not use his name to curse, swear, lie or deceive, or use witchcraft, but call upon God's name in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.

### THE THIRD COMMANDMENT

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we do not despise preaching and his Word, but regard it as holy, and gladly hear and learn it.

#### **THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT**

Honor your father and mother, that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we do not dishonor or anger our parents and others in authority, but honor, serve, and obey them, and give them love and respect.

#### **THE FIFTH COMMANDMENT**

You shall not murder.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and befriend him in every bodily need.

#### **THE SIXTH COMMANDMENT**

You shall not commit adultery.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we lead a pure and decent life in words and actions, and that husband and wife love and honor each other.

#### **THE SEVENTH COMMANDMENT**

You shall not steal.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we do not take our neighbor's money or property or get it by dishonest dealing, but help him to improve and protect his property and means of income.

#### **THE EIGHTH COMMANDMENT**

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, or give him a bad name, but defend him, speak well of him, and take his words and actions in the kindest possible way.

#### **THE NINTH COMMANDMENT**

You shall not covet your neighbor's house.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house or obtain it by a show of right, but do all we can to help him keep it.

#### **THE TENTH COMMANDMENT**

You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, workers, animals, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

*What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God that we do not force or entice away our neighbor's spouse, workers, or animals, but urge them to stay and do their duty.

#### **THE CONCLUSION**

What does God say about all these commandments? He says, "I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments."

*What does this mean?*

God threatens to punish all who transgress these commandments. Therefore we should fear his anger and not disobey what he commands. But he promises grace and every blessing to all who keep these commandments. Therefore we should love and trust in him, and gladly obey what he commands.

## The Apostle's Creed

### THE FIRST ARTICLE (Creation)

I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

*What does this mean?*

I believe that God created me and all that exists, and that he gave me my body and soul, eyes, ears and all my members, my mind and all my abilities. And I believe that God still preserves me by richly and daily providing clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, spouse and children, land, cattle, and all I own, and all I need to keep my body and life. God also preserves me by defending me against all danger, guarding and protecting me from all evil. All this God does only because he is my good and merciful Father in heaven, and not because I have earned or deserved it. For all this I ought to thank and praise, to serve and obey him. This is most certainly true.

### THE SECOND ARTICLE (Redemption)

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

*What does this mean?*

I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the virgin Mary, is my Lord. He has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, purchased and won me from all sins, from death and from the power of the devil, not with gold or silver, but with his holy, precious blood and with his innocent suffering and death.

All this he did that I should be his own, and live under him in his kingdom, and serve him in everlasting righteousness, innocence and blessedness, just as he has risen from death and lives and rules eternally. This is most certainly true.

### THE THIRD ARTICLE (Sanctification)

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

*What does this mean?*

I believe that I cannot by my own thinking or choosing believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to him.

But the Holy Spirit has called me by the gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith. In the same way he calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith.

In this Christian Church he daily and fully forgives all sins to me and all believers.

On the Last Day he will raise me and all the dead, and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true.
